Israel's Agony

Israel is now totally isolated among the nations of the world. For most of Israel's modern history America has been her benefactor, this is no longer true. (that scenario has changed.)

Cal Thomas wrote on March 18, 2010: "Despite Vice President Joe Biden's recent pledge of unswerving fidelity to Israel during his recent visit there, the rhetoric and pressure directed by the Obama administration against the only fully functioning democracy in the Middle East more accurately resembles the behaviour of an enemy.

Increasingly under this administration — but also present in Republican administrations — America's policy toward Israel is full of "harmful designs" and "antagonistic activities." The intentions may not be deliberate, but the outcome would lead to the same injurious end."

Last week the Obama administration denounced Israel's intention to build houses in Jerusalem. Hillary Clinton turned down Israel's initial proposals for easing the upset and laid down three prerequisites for restoring normal relations with Jerusalem:

- The Netanyahu government must extend the 10 month freeze on West Bank settlement construction to include East Jerusalem.
- When the moratorium runs out in September, it must be renewed for the duration of peace negotiations with the Palestinians.
- 3. Israel must make more concessions to the Palestinian Authority and its chairman, Mahmoud Abbas.

The Israeli government has been informed that until these conditions are met, its ministers will not be received in Washington by high-level American officials - a virtual boycott downgrades which the normal diplomatic. strategic and security exchanges between the two administrations and extends to the level of Senators and the special Middle East envoy George Mitchell.

Obama and Clinton have made it clear that they will brook no departures from these three demands, which Israel is required to treat as an ultimatum.

Neither party to the difference has mentioned the US administration's fourth condition for resuming normal relations:

 an Israeli commitment to refrain from attacking Iran's nuclear program without prior US consent.

Because this commitment has not been made, administration officials are continuing to hammer Israel in every possible arena. Indeed, the gloves are now off in earnest for insinuation that Israel's settlement policy is the root-cause of Iran's drive for a nuclear bomb, and of the conflicts endangering American lives in combat in Afghanistan and Iraq.

A much-admired American military figure, CENTCOM chief, Gen. David Petraeus, was the next US official to put this linkage into words. In his briefing to a Senate panel on Wednesday March 16, he said: "Clearly the tensions on these issues with Israel have enormous effect on the strategic context in which we operate in the Central Command's area of responsibility."

The general denied that he had as yet formally asked for the Palestinian territories to be transferred to his command, but added: "In fact, staff members at various times have discussed asking for the Palestinian territories to be added to CENTCOM's turf."

Debkafile's military sources explain that, if approved, this step would be tantamount to providing the Palestinians with an American military umbrella against Israel.

In his testimony in Washington, Former Republican Presidential candidate, Senator John McCain, caught on the lay of the land in the Obama Washington. During his testimony, he asked: "Isn't the issue not the issue of settlements as much as it is the existence of the state of Israel...? So maybe you could put it all into the larger context of what needs to be done to reduce tensions on the US's closest ally and friend in many respects."

General Petraeus' response was not to respond to the challenge but rather to politely state: "Absolutely true."

It has been reported that Obama has promised to give Abbas, all that he is asking for, indeed why should Abbas

US facility in Jordan." It is hard to believe that these troops will not eventually turn their guns on Israel. Arutz Sheva, reported the following, "The Jewish Institute for National Security Affairs (JINSA) revealed in a January report that was updated recently that the government of Israel has been concealing a change in arms policy by the United States against the Jewish state. which I gave in the Civil Auditorium in Pasadena. While reaffirming the theological view of fundamentalism, this address repudiated its ecclesiology and its social theory. The ringing call for a repudiation of separatism and the summons to social involvement received a hearty response from many evangelicals. lt differed fundamentalism in its repudiation of separatism and its determination to engage itself in the theological dialogue of the day," Dr. Harold Ockenga.

Ockenga was saying, abandon separation and get involved with the world, that is exactly what the Evangelical Church has done for the last 60 years, this error has now come to full fruition and such a Church

cannot be reformed by dealing with the symptoms of its sickness, but must be abandoned. Separation is God's remedy for apostasy, this is an unalterable principal in the New Testament, disobey it at your own peril. Failure to separate from New Evangelicalism has been the breeding ground for apostasy.

"Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, and will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty." 2 Corinthians 6:17, 18.

The same doctrine is taught in passages such as Ephesians 5:11 which says, "And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them." It is the theme of 2 John, culminating in verses 10 and 11: "If there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, receive him not into your house, neither bid him God speed: For he that biddeth him God speed is partaker of his evil deeds."

The New Testament calls for the believer to contend for the faith, it calls the believer to separate from the world and from ecclesiastical apostasy. We are warned that we will not be accepted by the world, that the world will hate us because it hated our Lord. We are told not to love the world but rather separate ourselves from the world. Down over the long centuries multitudes of followers of Christ were martyred for their separation from the world and for their contending for the truth of the Word of God. The apostles were martyred by a world that hates Christ and if we are true to the Apostles doctrine we will not be accepted by a world which has not changed.

In a press release dated December 8, 1957, Dr. Ockenga made the following statement: "The New Evangelicalism has changed its strategy from one of separation to one of infiltration." That has again has been the strategy of the Evangelical Church for the last 60 years. When you wrap a mud ball in a white sheet, guess which one changes color? Today you cannot tell most of the Evangelical Church from the world, guess who has changed? Guess who has been infiltrated?

The change brought upon the church by New Evangelicalism, was not the neglect of a doctrine, but rather the departure from the very essence of what the church is to be. It was the abandonment of the church's pilgrim nature. The church is a group called out from the world, called to be separate from the world.

We thank God for those Pastors and Churches that are still Fundamentalists; they are the remnant of the Philadelphian Church which will endure until the rapture. Find one and join it! Come out of Laodicea!

Today the Evangelical Church is in love with the world, it is trying to win the favour of the world. It is trying to draw the world into the place where it does not belong, into the church. It is in love with the world and the things of the world, it is in love with the pleasures of the world, and it is bringing the world and it's music and it's methods into the church. Instead of the church winning the world the world has won There is church. redeemable of such a church, it continues to slip further and further into apostasy and it must be separated from.

The New Evangelical Church, has determined to find acceptance with the world, and it has been largely successful, but in doing so, they have accepted the world, they have changed, not the world.

The Evangelical Church added the social gospel to the biblical gospel, and they have mixed in the gospel of easybelievism and they now have another gospel, which as Paul said, is not the gospel.

We are reminded of the warning to Laodicea, "So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spew you out of my mouth." Revelation 3:16.

And we are reminded of Matthew 24:5 where Jesus warned of the great last days deception, "For many shall come in my name saying, I am Christ (I am a minister of the gospel) and shall deceive many."

In Matthew 7:21-22, Jesus said, (I believe, to Laodiceans) "Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? And in thy name cast out devils? And in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity."

In Revelation 18:4, Jesus said to those in the apostate church in that hour, "Come out of her, my people, that ye be

not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive of her plagues."

John described Laodicea as a church that was blind and deceived; I believe that is a description of the Evangelical church of this very hour.

Three hundred years ago those who loved the Lord and wanted to worship Him freely without persecution left the shores of England and Europe to make the dangerous trip to the New World. They cherished the opportunity to freely worship the God they loved, and they endured tremendous hardships to win this freedom. God

Now at this very hour that freedom is being taken away by those who are repeating the same injustice and intolerance of the past. We have recently learned about the city of Gilbert, Arizona and their demand that a group having a Bible study in their home must cease and desist claiming that they are violating zoning bylaws.

Now in Rancho Cucamonga California, the city has ordered a Friday night bible study involving a dozen people to shut down it's meetings. The members are faced with financial sanctions unless they buy a very expensive permit from the city. The city officials say they are not budging on the issue. There was also a similar issue last year in San Diego County.

Rancho Cucamonga officials are demanding that the small home Bible study group stop meeting – or apply to purchase a Conditional Use Permit that also would be required for a full church operation.

Dacus said, the study group has been meeting Friday nights and averages about 15 people. Members are affiliated with Shiloh Tabernacle, which rents a community center for Sunday services.

The city recently dispatched a letter to the homeowner insisting the study is not allowed because it is a "church," Dacus said. In the city, churches are required to obtain a "Conditional Use Permit" in residential areas.

"The city has also indicated that no Conditional Use Permit would be granted and the gatherings must cease by Good Friday, April 2," PJI said.

Dacus said, the city's stance is a significant problem because its definition of a church is so broad, according to their definition, a family praying over their dinner would qualify as a church," he told WND.

"This is no misunderstanding," he said. "In this case the city knows exactly what they're doing, exactly what the facts are, and they're not budging."

The city, however, has no similar restrictions for Monday night football parties or various other events that would be held in homes, PJI pointed out.(unquote)
